The first in a series of workshops seeking input for a Manitou Incline management plan that will guide future decision making regarding public recreation at the Incline takes place June 24 at 7 p.m. in Manitou Springs City Hall.

The project is managed by the City of Colorado Springs Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department with support from the City of Manitou Springs and funding from Great Outdoors Colorado.

- July 14 - Trails and trailhead focus area session
- July 15 - Management and operations focus area session
