

## **Council adopts new fee schedule**

Manitou Springs City Council on Tuesday set new, higher fees for use of city parks and Memorial Hall.

The new fees aim to capture the city's costs in renting out its facilities. Council also is considering a fee waiver policy, which will be taken up at a later date.

The following rates are now in effect for local and nonlocal users (if not specified, fees are the same for both):

- Memorial Hall: \$25 for two hours Monday-Friday or \$200 per day for locals; \$50 for two hours Monday-Friday or \$400 per day for nonlocals
- Memorial Hall set-up or teardown: \$100 per day
- Memorial Hall alcohol review: \$125
- Liquor license: \$150
- Seven Minute Gazebo: \$200 for three hours or \$300 per day for locals; \$250 for three hours or \$350 per day for nonlocals
- Mansions Pavilion: \$75 per day plus \$50 for an event with 100 or more participants for locals; \$100 per day plus \$50 for more than 100 participants for nonlocals; maximum use 200 people
- Soda Springs Park, including the pavilion, and Memorial Park: \$100 per day plus \$50 for 100-499 or \$100 for 500 or more participants for locals; \$150 per day plus \$50 for 100-499 or \$100 for 500 or more for nonlocals
- Soda Springs Park Pavilion only: \$75 for locals; \$125 for nonlocals
- Vendor fee: \$10 each per day/per event; maximum \$350
- Special event application fee: \$25

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
